

Thank you for purchasing the Level Bedded D&D Jail Expansion. We recommend using a standard PVA wood glue on this product to ensure a good bond to the wood. Other useful tools to help you assemble your D&D Wagon kit would be a toothpick or brush to apply the PVA with masking tape to help hold it in place whilst it glues up.

This is one of the Expansion for our D&D Wagon kits. We will be bringing out more expansions and add-ons for our Wagon, so keep an eye on our etsy store and social media for new designs that will help change the style of your wagon to better fit the sort of story you want to tell.



These are all the panels which should be included with your Jail expansion.

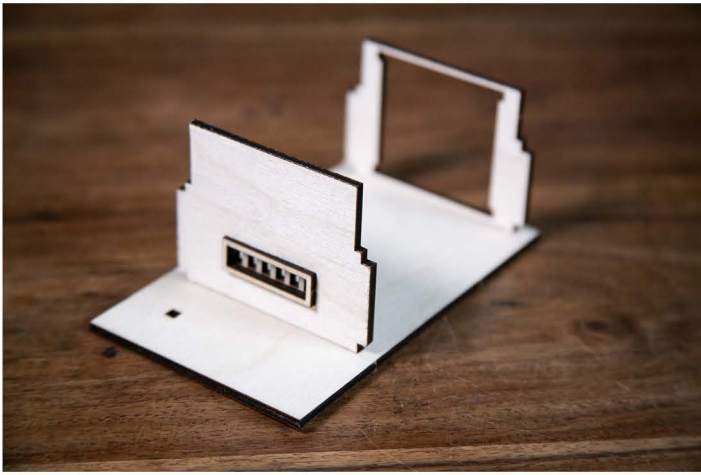
1) Prepare the magnet panels and side panels for gluing together. Ensure the magnet panels are facing downwards and the side panels are glued in as shown above.



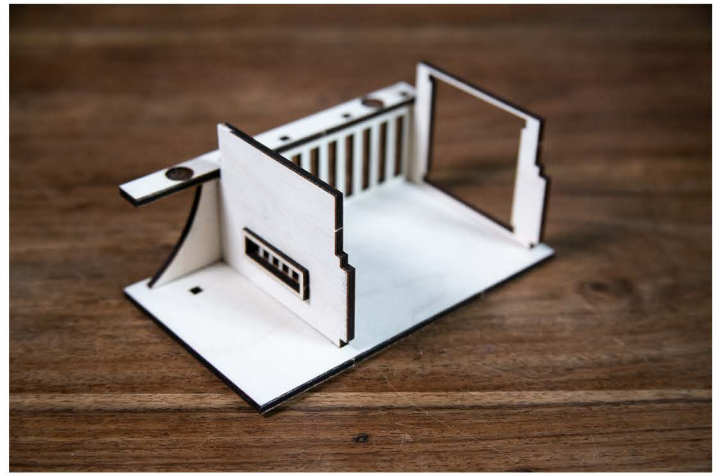
2) Once together, glue the additional detail to the side panel ensuring it is glued to the side closest to the magnet panel and repeat on the other side panel.

3) Then, take the front panel and glue the two smaller rectangular panels into the gap provided as shown above.

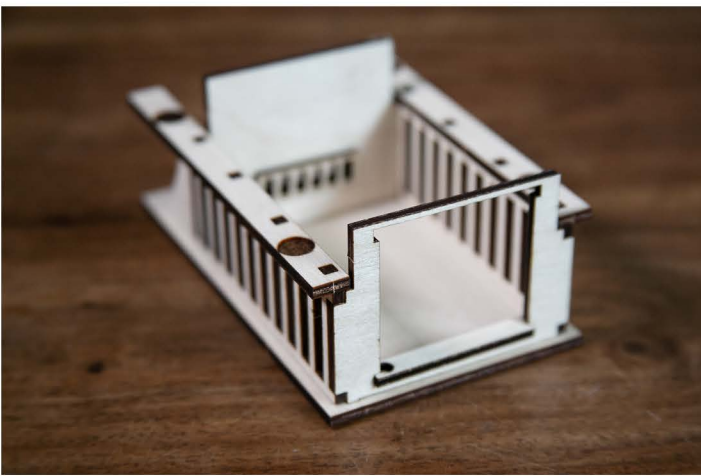




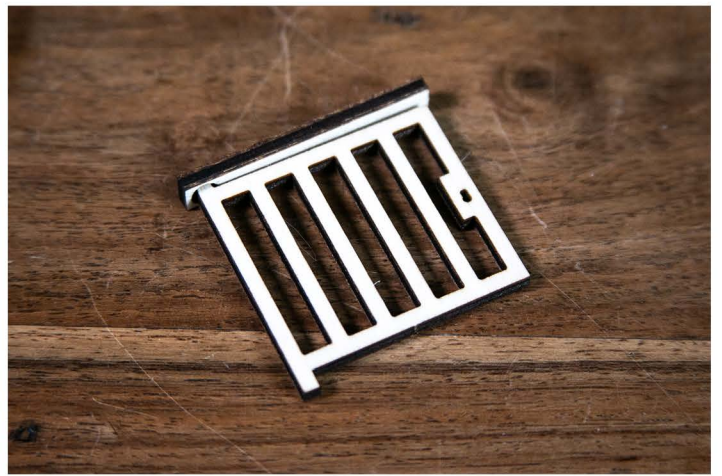
6) Next, glue the front panel and back panels onto the top board as shown above. Ensure the front panel is placed near the additional hole.



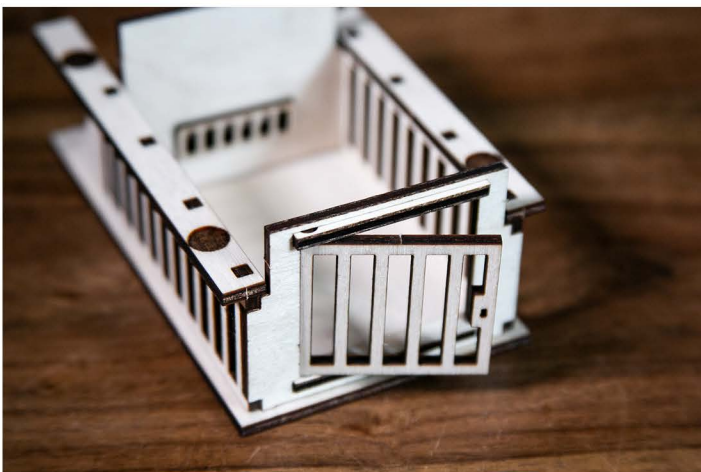
7) After this, attach the side panels to the frame ensuring the curve of the side panels are facing towards the front.



8) For the door, glue in the first door hinge panel to the top of the door frame.



9) Slot the door into the hole of the hinge and glue the top of the hinge panel.



10) After gluing, slide the door into place as shown above. Make sure not to get any glue near where the door needs to swing.



11) For the lantern, simply glue the two halves together with the design facing the same direction. The glue it into the hole in the top panel as shown above.

You can now enjoy your fully finished jail.
